Winnebago County Jail continues to be the only corrections facility open in District 02 to AA volunteers going in to carry the message. Unfortunately, numerous individuals who have shown interest in carrying the message into Winnebago County Jail have had their applications denied. Laurie O. requested feedback from the Winnebago County Jail contact on what criteria they are using to evaluate applicants. They informed Laurie O. that "they look at the seriousness of any prior convictions, length of time since last incarceration (at least 5 years if they were housed here) and if they have any personal relationships with current inmates that could be a potential issue." This information will be shared with future applicants interested in working at the Winnebago County Jail. Women and men volunteers are still needed for this facility.

The Corrections Committee will be purchasing Big Books and Daily Reflections.

Tim M. reported that Jeff R. continues to check the PO Box for Bridging-the-Gap forms. One form has been received.

Kim R. noted that she has received an email from Outagamie County Jail that they plan to allow AA volunteers back in June.


