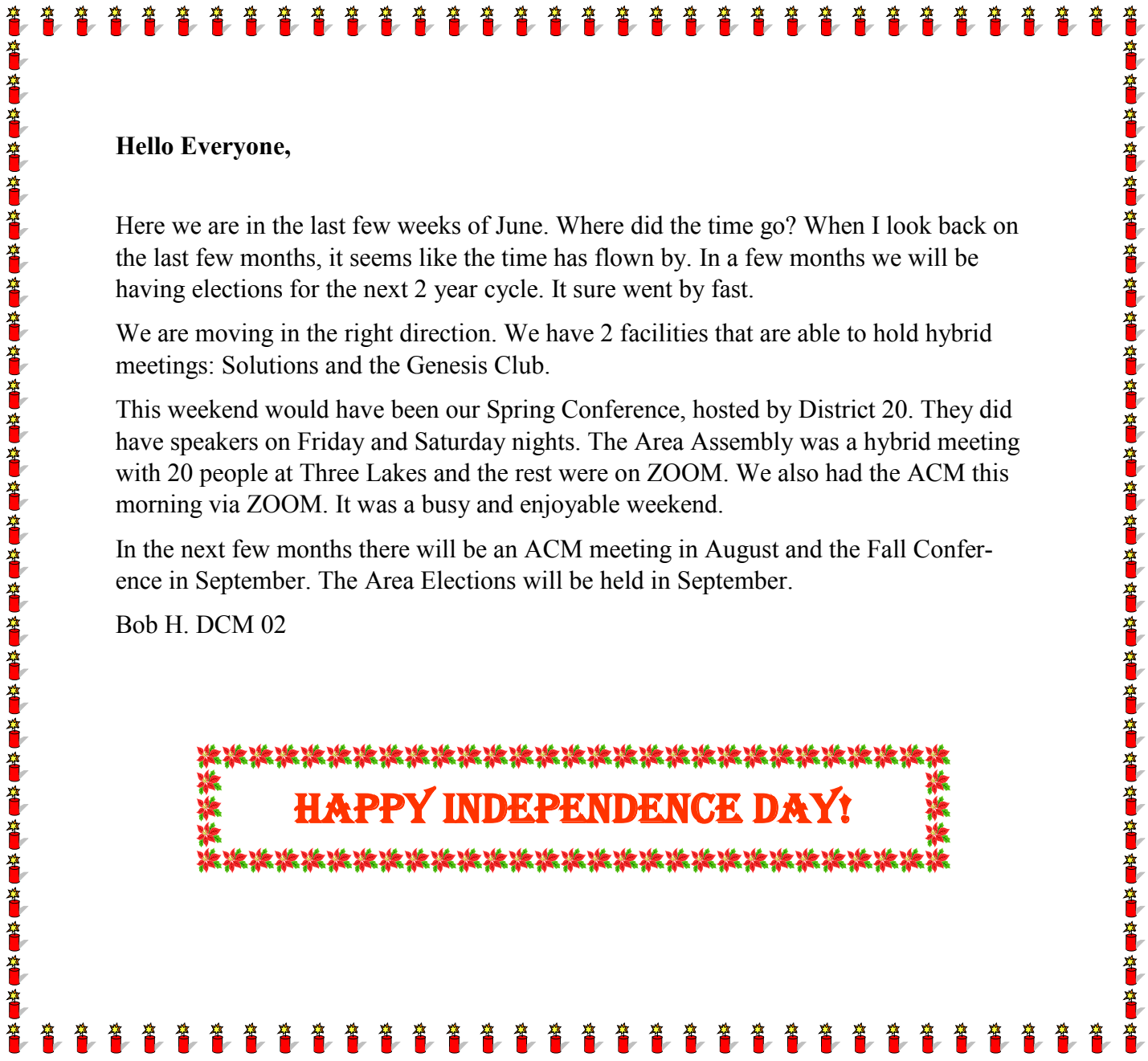

#### Ad-Hoc District Website Committee Report

Members: Karen, Laurie, Tom, Rachel, Barb, Kimmerly, Jon, Kendra, and Trevor (PS Bob said he's not part of the committee; he just wanted to observe and know what we were up to)

In May 2020, the committee unanimously voted to hire TechNetLLC, a local company that supports and maintains another recovery Website. Focus: immediate need to get district email system working, services to upload/change Webpage information and create a Webpage for individual AA groups and District-hosted ZOOM meetings. Cost of annual Website and email support/consultation services: \$499.00. This low cost was provided to the District at the same rate as other similar organizations in the area. The email service used by the District needed to be updated as it only allowed one email account. This was an added cost of \$180.00 to purchase C Panel, a Web-hosting platform (\$120.00 for C Panel and \$60.00 per hour for IT Services). District emails are again working! An online AA meeting Webpage was developed and a best practices document is posted for AA groups hosting online meetings and an electronic form for individual groups to "sign up" to list its group on the District Website. Resources for AA members and content changes to the current layout of the District Website were made to make the Website more user friendly. We are in the process of a developing a new Website design using C Panel that allows more functionality and we will be moving away from the GoDaddy Website this summer. (Trevor, we need some guidance here about contracts, etc., with GoDaddy and the Web domain for District 02 and how that all transitions. We would like that to be as seamless as possible.)

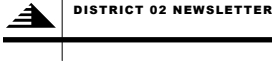
